MTP was set up in 1985 thanks to the experience and creativity of the two managers Roberto and Giandomenico Pierozzi.

They have resumed the activity, since their father started working with textiles at the beginning of the Sixties.

He had two factories, weaving and warping department.

His sons started selling and promoting their own textiles, creating a worldwide commercial net.

Actually also the third generation (Roberto's and Giandomenico's sons) work in the company as the result of the evolution of the factory.

Since one year MTP has reopened its weaving department to guarantee continual development, exclusiveness and originality of collections.



PRODUCTION

Mtp has two different collections:

- The first one consists of imported fabrics, basic qualities, most of them piece-dyed.

This kind of fabrics are directed to ready-to-wear customers.

- The second collection, is the most important one since all fabrics are 100% made and manufactured in Italy, focused on best raw materials, to guarantee a good quality of textiles, and on new trend inspirations to achieve the best fashion products for our customers.

Our Made in Italy collection is a total look collection, that includes fabrics for shirts, for dresses in cotton or mixed wool, stretch fabrics for trousers in various compositions, for blazers and coats, doubleface and high fancy yarn/bouclé fabrics.

Over the year the level of specialization has been enhanced through the constant attention from our technical and development department at market's evolution .
